❖ Day of Prayer and Reflection for Gaza on Sunday 24th August 2025: Archbishop Dermot Farrell has asked all parishes in the Archdiocese to dedicate Sunday 24th August as a special day of prayer and reflection for Gaza and for a renewed commitment by the international community for a just and lasting peace in the Middle East. This appeal in conjunction with Archbishop Eamon Martin of Armagh unites us in prayer before God, crying out for an end to all the terror and violence being perpetrated with tragic results for all. We are asked to light a candle in our home, attend Mass, or maybe say the Rosary; make some small personal penance of sacrifice, and on that day let the light of hope radiate out from the island of Ireland for peace, for Gaza and for the future of its people.

❖ Pockets of Hope - Pilgrimage Season 2025: The Archdiocese of Dublin's Pilgrim Season continues. The Pilgrim route includes St. Andrew's Church, Westland Row, Church of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, City Quay, Our Lady of Lourdes, Sean McDermott Street and St. Mary's Pro -Cathedral, Marlborough Street. Fr. Tom has set aside Saturday 23rd August to complete the Pilgrim route and wishes to invite anyone interested to join him. He intends to leave the church carpark at 9.30am and return mid-afternoon.
