- World Mission Sunday: This Sunday 19th October, we will celebrate World Mission Sunday, the Holy Father's annual appeal to support overseas mission and missionaries. This appeal will replace our usual Share Collection. Please give as generously as you can and thank you.
- Eucharistic Adoration in our Parish: The Archbishop has invited parishes to deepen their commitment to Eucharistic Adoration. That our prayerful time before the Lord present in the Eucharist underpin all our parish activity. Over the weekend 8th and 9th November, we will have a talk at each of the masses from The Apostolate of Eucharistic Adoration. They will explain the gift and invitation to adore Jesus' call present in the Eucharist. It is a beautiful opportunity to spend quiet time in prayer and reflection before the Blessed Sacrament. Over this weekend we will have the opportunity to build adoration in our parish.
- * The 800th Anniversary of the Canonisation of St. Lawrence O'Toole: Castledermot will mark this historical event for our parish, with a special Mass composed by Brian Kehoe.
